However, we do acknowledge that we face a wide range of hazards in our industry. We have a duty to manage those hazards through effective controls such that the residual risks are minimised so far as is reasonably practicable.

This policy, its standards and the strategic framework are set out in the Group Health and Safety Policy and Standards - it is for the Managing Directors and Chief Executives of the Operating Companies to put this policy and strategy into practice effectively through their own Health and Safety Management Systems. The Group audits Operating Companies annually and measures and reports our overall Health and Safety performance to The Go-Ahead Group plc Board through the Audit Committee as required.

Everyone in the Go-Ahead Group has a personal responsibility for the Health and Safety of themselves and those around them and for the wellbeing of everyone that comes into contact with our business. They have a vital role in adhering to our policy, procedures and rules as we strive to deliver a business that promotes health and wellbeing and aspires to be accident-free.
