As Capital Build Manager – Infrastructure in our Bus Division you will have demonstrable construction project management experience and will play a key role in the development and delivery of multiple projects with a team of Major and Minor works PMs to assist. This programme will include both new build, structural enhancement, and refurbishment schemes as well as the electrification of our garages. Reporting to the Head of Infrastructure you will be responsible for the day- to-day project and programme management including, leading projects from outline business case, through design, procurement, and delivery.

Key Accountabilities:

The Capital Project Manager will work collaboratively to inform building design and manage project delivery from conception to completion. You will ensure that projects are delivered in accordance with Go-Ahead's needs, statutory regulations, and to the agreed specification, whilst seeking to make improvements in environmental sustainability.

The post-holder will manage multiple projects and deploy a full range of skills in project management methodology including programme planning, reporting, budget management, risk management and cashflow forecasting.
